The two main repositories for records relating to military service are the National Archives and the National Personnel Records Center (NPRC). The National Archives Building, Washington, D.C., holds records relating to:

- Volunteer enlisted men and officers whose military service was performed during an emergency and whose service was considered to be in the federal interest, 1775 to 1902
- Regular Army enlisted personnel, serving 1789–October 31, 1912
- Regular Army officers, serving 1789–June 30, 1917
- U.S. Navy enlisted personnel, serving 1798–1885
- U.S. Navy officers, serving 1798–1902
- U.S. Marine Corps enlisted personnel, serving 1798–1904
- Some U.S. Marine Corps officers, serving 1798–1895
- Those who served in predecessor agencies to the U.S. Coast Guard (i.e., the Revenue Cutter Service [Revenue Marine], the Life-Saving Service, and the Lighthouse Service, 1791–1919)

A Veteran's Military Life Cycle –

Records you should look for as an aid to Genealogy

- Register for Selective Service (The Draft) Males only in the US
 - Before 1975
 - Registration eliminated between 1975 and 1980
 - 1980 to present 18 26 year old males born on or after 1 Jan 1960
 - only men born between 29 March 1957, and 31 December 1959, were completely exempt from Selective Service registration.
- Drafted Draft card often records this
- Enlistment or entry into officer training program
- Military Service Record (OMPF) awards, pay, training, deployments, etc
- Discharge Administrative or Final

Schwalm Examples of Service Entry

- Entered Purdue
 University via Army
 ROTC Program in 1932
- Graduated as Mechanical Engineer in 1936
- Commissioned as Reserve Artillery Officer and joined a unit in Connecticut, mobilized in 1942 to 6th Armored Div
- Never registered for the draft

- Ross Harold Schwalm
- Entered USMC Platoon Leaders Class in 1979
- Commissioned as USMC Reserve 2nd LT in 1981
- Active duty started July 1981 to include training as an artillery officer
- Discharged from Reserves and became a Regular Officer in 1984
- Never registered for the draft

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



M 11 February, 1924, the same year they met in Texas, in College Station, Brazos Co., Texas. D 11 September, 1948 of self inflicted gun shot and was buried in Texas. His wife made application for a headstone for him on 1 October, 1948, indicating that he enlisted on 11 December, 1913 and was discharged on 1 October, 1944 as a Staff Sergeant in the U S Army Texas Co. ROTC, College Station, Bryan, Texas with serial # 1407890. Death date is indicated as 11 September, 1948, with burial in the city cemetery. Her name was listed as Mrs. Clara J Schwalm, 907 East 29th Street, Bryan, Texas

My Dad – Ben L. Schwalm

- Father died 1 Dec 1921 when he was 2
- Started working at age 9 at the Nelson Ice Plant driving an ice delivery truck
- Graduated HS School in 1936
- Registered for the WW II Draft in 1940
- Was working as a Beer Distributor when drafted in Spring 1943
- Dating his future wife, Gertrue Thompson, before he was drafted. Her pen name was "Dearest"



Last of the Fighting Thompsons

- Followed in the footsteps of his Civil War ancestors George, David, William Wallace and Robert Bruce (All from Middleport, PA)
 - David and William settled in Porter Township after the Civil War
- Four older brothers born between 1896–1904
 - Three that lived were all too old for WW II
- Two younger brothers born in 1915 & 1918
 - Charles was mentally retarded from birth
 - Paul got polio as a child and was not medically qualified for service
- Ross was drafted as the only eligible one from a large family
 - His nephews Ben and Ross Schwalm were Fighting Thompsons!







Multiple Kesslers' served in the Civil War

Born 15 Mar 1841 which matches age of 21 in Sep 1861

Unsure when he returned to unit after time in hospital. Unknown if he was wounded or was sick.

Apparently reenlisted Aug 30, 1864

Served until Jan 24, 1866 (this explains why he was not on muster roll when the rest of the unit mustered out.)

Lived in Williamstown, PA when a Veterans roll was taken in 1890. Was collecting a pension as "Invalid" Death certificate in 1919 indicated "Blind".

Additional Research under way to confirm service, nature of hospitalization and post Civil War life.


